Oh Lord	A person who does not submit the tithe but performs all the prescribed rituals. Such a person is regarded as a great saint (outwardly). Without the submission of the tithe, he will not rise higher and will not achieve Divine vision (didar). Hari You are eternal;
Āshāji	thul daso(n)d dio mora bhai to mule mul samanaji pachhe dharam virabhai tame karjo to daredar samayhari
Oh Lord	Oh my brothers submit the tithe which functions as the trunk of the tree (of life), keeps all the roots in their place. After that if you perform all the outward religious duties then all the branches will grow spontaneously, i.e., you will prosper. Hari You are eternal;
